RESOLUTION PERMITTING ABSENTEE VOTING IN BUNN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS


WHEREAS, Absentee voting is not currently permitted in the municipals elections in the Town of Bunn; and


WHEREAS, the Bunn Board of Commissioners desires that the citizens of Bunn be allowed to vote by absentee ballot in Bunn municipal elections.
