**WHEREAS,** North Carolina General Statute 143-128 requires that Public Contracts for the State, or any County, Municipality or other public body have established procedures for Minority Business Participation, and

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Bunn supports Minority Business Participation in all of their contracts.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
THE TOWN OF BUNN:**


That the Town of Bunn supports the intent and reporting requirements for all contracts into which it enters per NC General Statute 143-128.

That the Town of Bunn shall award public building contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or handicapping condition, as defined in General Statute 168A-3.

That the Town of Bunn will require the awarding authority to take action to ensure a good faith effort in the recruitment and selection of minority businesses for participation in contracts awarded.

That the Town of Bunn shall require a ten percent (10%) goal for participation by minority businesses in all publicly bid construction contracts.


