RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF BUNN TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERMS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS BE CHANGED FROM TWO YEAR TERMS TO STAGGERED FOUR YEAR TERMS

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and 160A-102, the Bunn Town Council intends to adopt an ordinance amending the Charter of the Town of Bunn to implement staggered, four year terms of office for the mayor and members of the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, G.S. 160A-102, requires the proposed Charter amendment first be submitted to a public hearing and that due notice thereof be published not less than ten days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing; and

WHERAS, A Public Hearing was held for the public on the 21st day of March, 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of The Town of Bunn that: At the November 8, 2005 election, the mayor and the two members of the council receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to a four year terms of office. The two members of the council receiving the lowest number of votes will be elected to a one time two year term. At the next election, two members of the council shall be elected to begin serving a four year term of office. Thereafter, members shall be elected every two years for a staggered four year term of office.
