

ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES FOR PARADE, DEMONSTRATIONS AND PROTESTS

WHEREAS, the Town of Bunn Board of Commissioners desire to adopt an ordinance for rules for Parades and Demonstrations.

WHEREAS, the Bunn Police Department has asked for restrictions on these rules as follows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Bunn, North Carolina that the following rules for Parade and Demonstrations are hereby adopted:

Parade Rules:

1. All drivers must be a least 21 years of age.
2. Minors participating must have adult supervision.
3. All vehicles and trailers must have a current and valid registration plate.
4. All vehicles and trailers must have proof of automobile insurance.
5. All drivers need to possess a valid license for the type of vehicle they are operating.
6. Must obtain a permit from the Bunn Town Hall.
7. No confetti is allowed.


Demonstration and Protest Rules:

1. Protests and demonstrations peacefully done are lawful under the First Amendment.
2. Must obtain a permit from the Bunn Town Hall.
3. Standing, sitting or lying upon highways or streets is prohibited G.S. 20-174.1
4. No violence or language that is intended to provoke violent retaliation and thereby causing a breach of peace G.S. 14-288.4
5. No trespassing on private property unless given authorization from the owner G.S. 14-159.13
6. No person shall disobey officer's orders that are designed to protect the health and safety of protesters and others. G.S. 14-223
7. No masks or weapons are permitted during any Demonstration or Protests.
8. No injury or destroying of real property whatsoever, either public or private in nature.


If any violations of the rules of this ordinance are not adhered to it could result in a felony, a misdemeanor or a citation by the Bunn Police Department.
