INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS:

Applications to participate in the 2024 Bunn Christmas Parade are now being accepted. Applications to print off will be located on the Town's Webpage (townofbunn.org). Entrants will be notified prior to the parade with their line up number information.

The Bunn Christmas parade is a fun-filled event with lots of participants and spectators. Parade instructions and rules are designed to remind participants to respect others and that sometimes even the most innocent actions can provoke significant problems in a crowded area. The rules are in place to ensure everyone's safety and that we have an orderly and joyful parade.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS and DRIVERS

Line-up begins at 1:00 pm. You are welcome to decorate your floats and vehicles in your assigned area. DO NOT leave any trash behind. Fines will be issued to those who do not follow the rules and instructions. All Entries MUST be in their assigned space no later than 2:45 to be allowed in the Parade Line-up.

- All drivers need to be at least 21 years of age
- Minors participating in the parade should have adequate adult supervision
- Passengers in parade vehicles are limited to one adult 18 or older
- All vehicles and trailers must have a current and valid registration plate
- All vehicles and trailers must have proof of automobile insurance coverage
- All drivers need to possess a valid license for the type of vehicle they are operating
- NO Confetti Cannons are to be used while on the parade route.

Entrance to the Line-up will be the second entrance on Bunn Elem School Rd. All participants must park and walk to their assigned space and not allowed to drive though the parade line-up area for drop off.

• PARADE ROUTE

- Parade entry begins at Bunn High School
- The Parade will move north on Main Street and continue past the four- way stop intersection
- The parade will turn left on Carolina Ave and disband (please DO NOT let participants off the float or trailer on the main route for safety)

PARADE RULES

- All children must be supervised and accompanied by adults, whether walking, marching or riding, at all times before,
 during, and after the parade. All hands and feet must be kept inside the vehicle and floats at all times. Be conscious of
 participant vehicles while in the parade line-up. Parade volunteers coordinate this event and are not responsible for
 children.
- Loud noises such as motorcycle/vehicles revving will absolutely not be tolerated since this can frighten children and animals in the parade. Vulgarity whether by participates or music will not be permitted. This will be cause for expulsion from the parade.
- Entries will not be permitted to stop to perform so there will be no gaps in the flow of the parade. Please choreograph your units so they will maintain a steady speed throughout the parade. Parade officials will be located throughout the route.
- We request that all teams, troops and tribes please wear their uniforms or matching attire and carry a sign or banner that identifies the group.
- Festival Attire is Required for all parade participants including parents and chaperones. All vehicles must be decorated with a Christmas Theme.
- The maximum number of riders on a homemade float is 15 and on a commercial float 12.
- Floats must come to a complete stop before participants disembark. Absolutely no one may jump from a float while it is in motion.

- Please make sure that all candy is being thrown to the outside of the street so that children are not running in the street to collect it. It is preferred that adults be the one that throws the candy.
- There is only one Santa allowed in the parade, provided by the Town of Bunn.

Commercial Floats are available for businesses and churches this year to rent for the parade. It will be a pulled Custom Float with a holiday theme. The Float will have your company name on the side. Each float can hold up to 12 participants. Each 1/4 float is allowed 3 participants
