SECTION 5. Funds appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 budget and encumbered on June 30, 2025 shall be authorized as part of the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 budget appropriation by adoption of this budget ordinance.

SECTION 6. There is hereby levied a tax rate of forty-five cents (.45) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of valuation for property listed for taxes as of January 1, 2025, for purpose of raising the revenue listed as current year Ad Valorem Tax in the General Fund under Section 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. The auto licenses general purpose (city tags) (G.S. 20-97) will be raised to \$20 for purposes of raising the revenue listed as current year Ad Valorem Tax in the General Fund under Section 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to transfer appropriations within departmental appropriations. The Finance Officer is not authorized to effect transfers between departmental appropriations or fund without the approval of a budget amendment.

SECTION 9. Copies of this Budget Ordinance shall be furnished to the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners and the Finance Officer and kept on file by them for their direction in the execution of their duties.
