

## **MULTI-YEAR WATER STORAGE TANK MAINTENANCE AND PAINTING PROGRAM**

The **Town of Bunn** is seeking sealed proposals from qualified and licensed contractors for a **Multi-Year Water Storage Tank Maintenance and Painting Contract**. This comprehensive program is intended to ensure the long-term structural integrity and aesthetic quality of the Town's potable water storage assets.

**Project Overview** The selected firm will be responsible for the professional maintenance, inspection, and painting of the Town's elevated water storage tank. The contract term is intended to be a multi-year agreement (e.g., 5-10 years) encompassing:

- **Initial Rehabilitation:** Exterior and interior cleaning, surface preparation, and full repainting.
- **Recurring Maintenance:** Annual visual inspections, washout/disinfection cycles, and minor repairs (e.g., gasket replacement, vent screen repairs).
- **Emergency Services:** Priority response for unplanned repairs or security issues.

**Submission Requirements** Bidders must be properly licensed under **Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes**. Proposals should include:

1. **Company Qualifications:** Documentation of at least 10 years of experience in municipal water tank maintenance.
2. **Safety Program:** A copy of the firm's safety manual and OSHA compliance record.
3. **Technical Approach:** Proposed coating systems (e.g., Tnemec or approved equal) and surface preparation methods.
4. **Pricing:** A detailed schedule of values for both initial capital work and annual maintenance fees.
